



Townhouse 27

The city's first 'boutique' hotel opened in 2008: 21 rooms and suites in a renovated 1929 building just off Knez Mihailova. An earthy palette (beige, grey, darkwood and exposed brick) runs throughout, and guest rooms are equipped with Bang & Olufsen TVs, espresso machines and, in the larger suites, soaking tubs. The best is the 60 sq m VIP Suite, but those looking on to the quiet side street, such as Suite 201 (above), are

a good option. The hotel has an airy ground-floor café/restaurant (opposite), or try Pire (see p049), minutes' walk away. Although it doesn't have a spa, Townhouse boasts a well-equipped gym and sauna, with a personal trainer on request. Bonus?
